Re: Sigmund Freud Museum

An exciting learning opportunity has been organised by the psychology department for our Year 10 students to visit the Sigmund Freud Museum on **Tuesday 1st July 2025**. This is a really great opportunity for students to relate what they have learnt in their psychology GCSE curriculum to the real-world of one of psychology's most famous founding fathers. We feel this trip will be benefitted by everyone who has chosen Psychology as a GCSE option as not only does it provide extra motivation for students to focus on their studies, but they will also attend a bespoke session from an experienced educational speaker who will be taking the students on a journey into the life and mind of Sigmund Freud. The talk will be focussing on how Freud developed psychotherapies (which are still used to treat mental health illnesses today), his ideas on schizophrenia and finally his famous works on the Interpretation of Dream.
