Principal's Challenge Trip – Eligibility Criteria

As we move into the summer term, we are preparing to launch the challenge that will decide the students who are invited on the Principal's Challenge Trip. There will be spaces for 50 students from each year group. These trips will take place on **Friday 10th July**, with Year 7 & 8 visiting Adventure Island in Southend, and Year 9 & 10 visiting Thorpe Park.

The challenge will run over a 6-week period, beginning **Monday 27th April** and ending on **Friday 12th June**. To qualify for the challenge students will need to have 97%+ attendance and complete the three challenges, which take place over 3 x 2-week periods.

Date	Challenge
Monday 27 th April – Friday 8 th May	Punctuality: No late to lesson marks
Monday 11 th May – Friday 22 nd May	Behaviour Points: No behaviour Points
Monday 1 st June – Friday 12 th June	Achievement Points: As many as possible

If more than 50 students in each year group are eligible for selection, places will be allocated based on the students who gained the most achievement points during the final two weeks of the challenge.

If your child is successful in gaining a place on the trip, we will be in touch shortly after the closing date.
