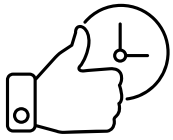
WELCOME TO Autumn 2

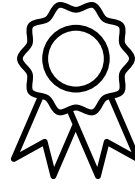

The student with the most challenges completed will receive £300!



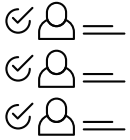
