**Re: Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Practice Expedition**

Your son/daughter has volunteered to attend the Duke of Edinburgh practice expedition on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2026. This is a great opportunity which cannot be missed to achieve the award. To attend, your son/daughter must have completed at least one of their three-month sections.

You should be aware that there are two different meeting and end points for the students depending on their walking group. Your son/daughter should meet and be collected at the points outlined in this letter.

Please read below for the essential information.

**Meeting Place Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2026:** 1st Moreton & Fyfield Scout Head Quarters, Rear of Houchin Drive, Fyfield, Essex, CM5 0RF.

**Meeting Time:** 10.00 am.

**Overnight accommodation:** Skreens Park Activity Centre, Skreens Park Rd, Chelmsford, CM1 4NN.

**Collection Address Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2024:** High Easter Village Hall, The Street, Chelmsford, Essex, CM1 4QS.

**Collection time:** Estimated time will be between 2-4pm but a phone call will be made when your son/daughter is towards the end of their walk.

**Price:** £17

Students are not permitted to use their mobile phones whilst on expedition. Students will be given a phone to use in case of emergencies. If your son/daughter wishes to bring their mobile phones, they can hand them into a member of staff on the Saturday morning before they begin their walk. The phone will then be returned to them once they have completed their expedition on the Sunday.

**Important kit information:**

It is essential that all kit is returned in the condition it was given out in. Tents must be dried out and cleaned, if this is not carried out it will result in them becoming mouldy and therefore ruined. Trangia's must be cleaned by hand and dried properly. Students will have the opportunity to complete this before they are collected from the expedition. **Please note that there will be a charge for any lost kit or kit that has not been cleaned and returned in the correct condition.**
