- In-School Artist Workshop & Q&A with professional glass artist Jon Lewis Monday 6th October, 3:45pm 5:30pm, Downstairs Dragon.
- Glassblowing Workshop at WorkInGlass
 Monday 21st October, 8:00am 5:30pm, Hainault Forest Country Park

Students have been researching Jon Lewis during lessons and are encouraged to bring thoughtful questions to the after-school session on 6th October, which will include a talk, artist Q&A, and live demonstrations.

On 20th October, your child will take part in a full-day workshop at WorkInGlass, where they will:

- Create their own unique handblown glass ornament in a 1-to-1 session
- Explore glass painting and creative design linked to their sketchbook coursework
- Gain experience that supports all four assessment objectives for their GCSE

This trip forms a key part of their final assessment and is an essential experience to support their coursework.

Trip Details - Tuesday 21st October

- Travel: School minibuses
- Arrival at School: 8:00am in the Heart space
- Return to School: Approx. 5:30pm
- Lunch: Students must bring their own food and drink. A small café is on-site but limited and at a cost.
- **Clothing:** Students must wear appropriate clothing and **closed footwear** no glassblowing can take place otherwise.
- Cost: £40 per student
