Re: Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Assessment Expedition

Your son/daughter has successfully completed their practice and will be attending the Duke of Edinburgh Assessment Expedition on Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th June 2025. This is a great opportunity which cannot be missed and in order to attend, your son/daughter must have completed their two 3-month sections.

You should be aware that there are two different meeting and end points for the students depending on their walking group. Your son/daughter should meet and be collected at the points outlined in this letter.

Please read below for the essential information.

Meeting place Saturday 14th June 2025: Boreham Village Hall, Main Road, Boreham, Chelmsford, CM3 3JD

Meeting Time: 10 am

Overnight accommodation: Essex Outdoors Danbury, Well Lane, Danbury, Essex, CM3 4AB.

Collection Address Sunday 15th June 2025: Purleigh Village Hall, The Glebe, Purleigh, Chelmsford, CM3 6PB.

Collection time: Estimated time will be between 2-4pm but a phone call will be made when your son/daughter is towards the end of their walk.

Price: £12

Students are not permitted to use their mobile phones whilst on expedition. Students will be given a phone to use in case of emergencies. If your son/daughter wishes to bring their mobile phones, they can hand them into a member of staff on the Saturday morning before they begin their walk. The phone will then be returned to them once they have completed their expedition on the Sunday.

IMPORTANT KIT INFORMATION:

It is essential that all kit is returned in the condition it was given out in. Tents must be dried out and cleaned, if this is not carried out it will result in them becoming mouldy, and therefore ruined. Trangia's must be cleaned by hand and dried properly. Students will have the opportunity to complete this before they are collected from the expedition. **Please note that there will be a charge for any lost kit or kit that has not been cleaned and returned in the correct condition.**
