Process around Examinations

- Conduct for written exams has already been sent out from our Exams Officer, Mrs Beatty, please review this ready for the start of exams on May 6th.
- Please ensure that students have all their correct equipment and it is exam compliant (clear water bottles, transparent pencil cases etc).
- Hair and Beauty Examination **will** be completed at Passmores Academy.

Expectations

- Students are expected to be in their *normal* lessons until the end of this half term (Friday May 22nd). Please remember that correct uniform **must** be worn for all exams.
- When we return on **Monday June 1st**, students will be expected to be in all lessons for which they still have exams. If the exams for that subject are finished, then they are not expected to be in for the lesson. Students of these subjects will be able to stay in the revision room or study at home. Attached is the Exam / Revision schedule. Please read this carefully as to when students are expected to be in. For a quick reference here is the last date for each subject, this is in date order:

Returning of Yondr Pouches

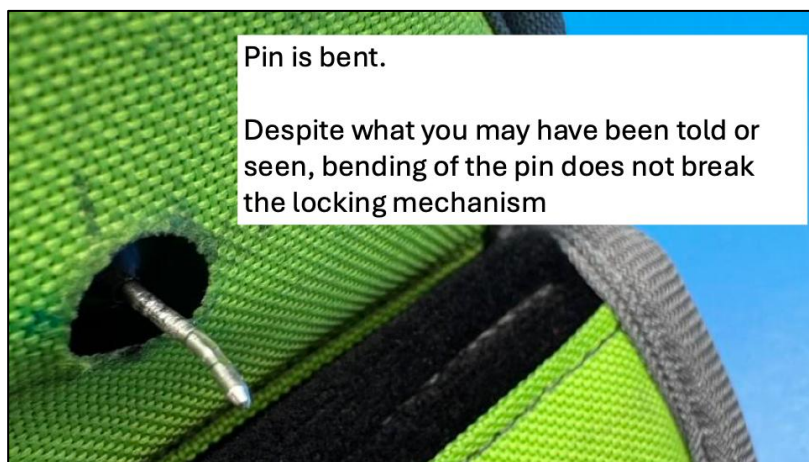
As you will recall, Yondr pouches were introduced approximately one year ago and were provided to students free of charge. These pouches remain the property of the school and are now required to be collected so that they can be reissued to our incoming Year 7 students.

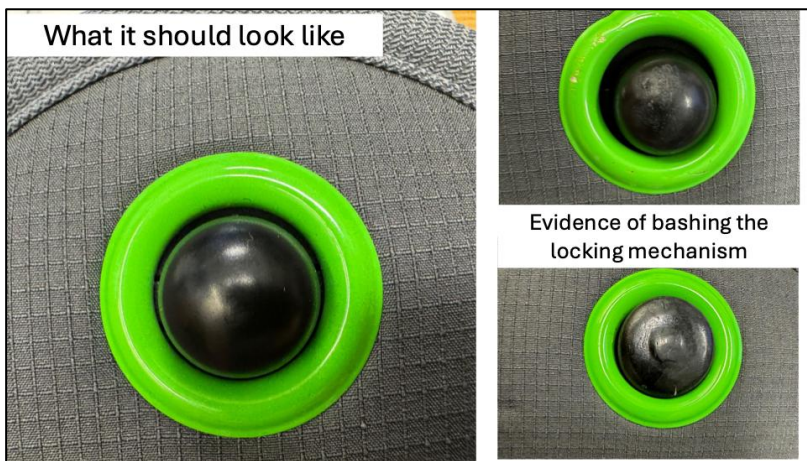
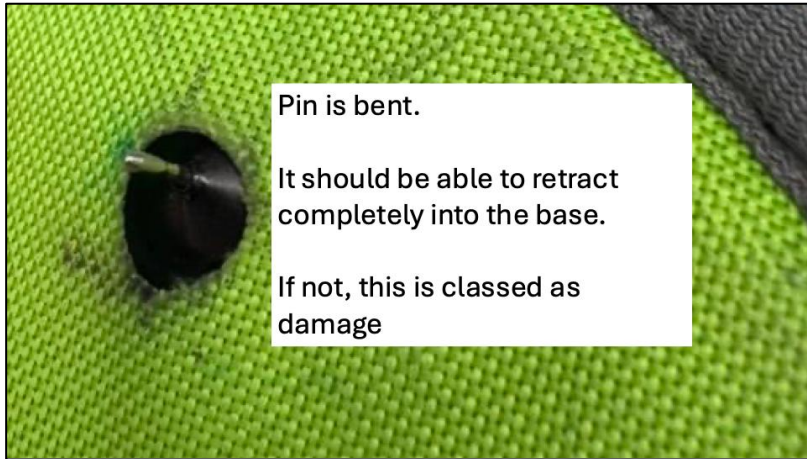
We therefore ask that **all Year 11 students return their Yondr pouch on Monday June 15th after the Physics Examination.**

At the time of introduction, families were advised that pouches must be returned in a suitable working condition. This includes being free from graffiti or markings, and having a fully functioning locking mechanism. Examples of unacceptable damage were shared at that point to ensure expectations were clear.

In line with this original agreement, **any pouch returned with damage including graffiti, a broken locking mechanism, or equivalent wear that prevents safe reuse will need to be replaced**, and a charge of **£15** will be applied to cover the cost of replacement.
