Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Photography Trip: London Galleries and Park - Wednesday 13th July

As part of your child's photography GCSE, they need to complete several coursework projects which count for 60% of the overall GCSE. In order for them to get as much out of the projects as possible, students would benefit from visiting more than one point of interest in order to fulfill their briefs and complete a variety of photoshoots.

We will start our day by visiting the Tate Modern, where students will be able to view several different collections, with the 'Personal Identity' project being the focus. In the afternoon we will walk along the South Bank towards the London Eye, where we will have several opportunities to stop and complete photoshoots. This trip is a fantastic opportunity and will be a great experience for all students, having a whole day dedicated to their photography.

The cost of the trip will be £10.00. You can pay via ParentPay or by cash. This covers all travel costs and insurance into London. There is a shop at the Tate Modern and places along the South Bank to buy food, if they wish to bring any money.

We will be travelling to London by coach, leaving Passmores at 8:30am. We will arrive back to Passmores in the afternoon, at approx. 4pm.

Students are expected to wear suitable casual clothes and **sensible walking shoes or trainers** as there will be a lot of walking. Please advise them to bring a waterproof jacket if it is forecast to rain, and/or alternatively sun cream if it is forecast to be hot. They should also bring a notebook, pen and a packed lunch.
