Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of the Year 11 course, we will be looking at urban geography and changes within towns and cities. Students are required to complete fieldwork on this topic, which will be examined on Paper 3 of their final exams. Therefore, we have organised a local visit to Harlow Town Centre on Tuesday 11th October 2022. Students will be off timetable for periods 1-3 and will need to catch up on any work missed in other lessons.

Students will meet at the Playhouse in the town at 9:15am for a presentation by David Sellings from Harlow Council to give an overview of our coursework investigation and provide secondary data, before conducting our surveys and leaving to return to school with their teachers at 1pm. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and water for the day or money to buy lunch at the town. The trip will go ahead regardless of the weather, so students should dress appropriately for rain or sunshine. **Uniform is required** and we will be walking back to school for period 4. Finally, all students **must** have a pen and pencil to complete the work.

There is no cost for this school trip. We remind all students that following instructions and good behaviour is paramount, and that students represent Passmores Academy as they go about their fieldwork. Anyone unable to behave as expected will be returned to normal lessons at school.
