Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to you to invite your child on a trip to see "*The Woman in Black*" at the Fortune Theatre, London. The trip will take place on **Tuesday 29th November 2022**.

The performance will allow the students to enjoy and engage with a chilling and gothic tale, alike "*The Strange Case of Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde*" which is one of their GCSE texts.

"*The Woman in Black*" is a ghost story about a lawyer who is obsessed with a curse that he believes has been cast over him and his family. It all begins innocently enough, but then, as we reach further into his darkest memories, the audience find themselves caught up in a world of eerie marshes and moaning winds.

There are 41 student tickets available and the cost of the trip including ticket and coach travel is **£33.00**. There are a limited number of tickets available and so they will be given on a first come, first served basis. If you would like your young person to attend but may need some financial support, please contact myself and the school will endeavour to help as best we can.

We will leave school at approximately **5pm** on the day of the trip and aim to return to school at **11:30pm**. Your young person will need to be picked up from school at this time.

Your young person may wear non-uniform on the trip but will need comfortable footwear.

They may bring money for food as they will have some free time before the performance but equally, they can bring food with them.
