Art Trip: Natural History/V&A Museum Tuesday 10th October 2023

The Natural History and V&A provide free events, festivals, opportunities, and resources for young people to experiment, create and innovate through art Design and Textiles ideas. In order for them to get as much out of Natural Forms project as possible, students would benefit from visiting a gallery to access first-hand research and ideas. At the Natural History and V&A students will be able to explore an array of free exhibitions and rooms which showcase the work of artists and designers.

During the trip we will be walking to the V&A and then onto the Natural History Museum. Students will be completing a series of practical drawing and photography tasks, with the focus being Natural Forms. This trip is a fantastic opportunity and will be a great experience for all students, having a whole day dedicated to their coursework.

The cost of the trip will be £12. You can pay via Parentpay or by cheque (cheques made payable to Passmores Academy). This covers all subsidized travel costs to London and educational visit into the Natural History and V&A.

We will be traveling to London by train so if I can ask that you get your son/daughter to Harlow Town train station no later than 9am, staff will be there from 8.45am. We will also be arriving back at Harlow Town train station at 4.30pm, so please can you plan to collect your son/daughter from the station.

Students are expected to wear suitable casual clothes and **sensible walking shoes or trainers**, as there will be a lot of walking. Please advise them to bring a waterproof jacket if it is forecast to rain. They should also bring a pencil, pen and a packed lunch or money for lunch.
