

Q: Will my young person still be able to travel if they don't have a GHIC/EHIC card?

A: Yes, the GHIC/EHIC card serves as a way of covering some of the cost of medical treatment should it be needed. If your young person doesn't have one, an emergency one can be applied for as and when it is needed.

Q: Will my young person need European plug adapters for travelling?

A: Yes, France uses a European plug (two prongs), an adapter will be needed to use UK based products.

Q: Will my young person need a hairdryer?

A: I have not had any confirmation whether there is a hairdryer in the room or not so I would recommend packing one if it is something you think you will need.

Q: What is the plan for food on Tuesday return?

A: We have a 2 hour wait between arriving at the Eurostar terminal and departure so we will use the services at the terminal for lunch. Approximately 10 Euros will be needed for this (similar to Sunday breakfast).

Q: What is the plan for travel clothes?

A: Your young person will need to travel in comfortable clothing that they can wear on Sunday in the park as we aren't able to check into our accommodation at the time we arrive (8:00am) they should also expect to need their deodorant to hand as they will have been on the coach a while and won't get to change clothes.

Q: Will the coach have chargers?

A: Yes, there are USB ports in the seat groups that will allow for phone charging.
