## Collection of GCSE Results Summer 2024 08.30am – 10.30am - Thursday 22 August 2024

I am writing to provide you with information regarding the collection of the summer 2024 examination results.

Examination results are available for collection from school between **08.30am and 10.30am on Thursday 22 August 2024**. Results will be distributed in the Heart Space.

If students are unable to collect personally and are sending a representative, please ensure they have written authority signed by the student, naming the person collecting the results. Identification may also be requested. Results may also be posted. For this, please ensure a stamped, self-addressed envelope is forwarded to me before the end of term (23.7.24).

Unfortunately, results cannot be given via email or phone on results day. Any results not collected will be retained in school and will be available for collection from Friday 23 August from the school reception.

Please be aware that certificates issued on Results Day are only preliminary certificates. Actual certificates will arrive in centre from early November. You will be notified via email when these are ready for collection.

We hope that these results are as expected or better. However, we all know that on occasion results are not as we would have hoped, and some may have just missed the next grade boundary. As a school we may ask for your permission to send for a re-mark if we feel that there is the likelihood of a grade being changed (this will be a very small percentage). In the event that we don't request a remark you can of course do this as parents/carers at the cost of the original entry ranging from £35.00 to £78.00 depending on the subject. Please be mindful that on the rare occasion, some results can be down-graded. I will be around on results day to provide more information on this, should it be required.
