Vocational courses

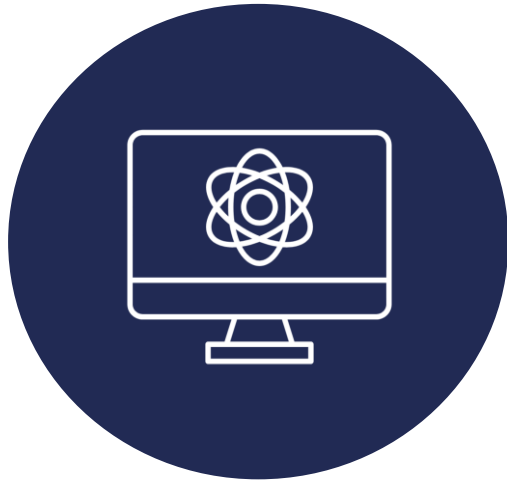
1. Coursework throughout the 2 years

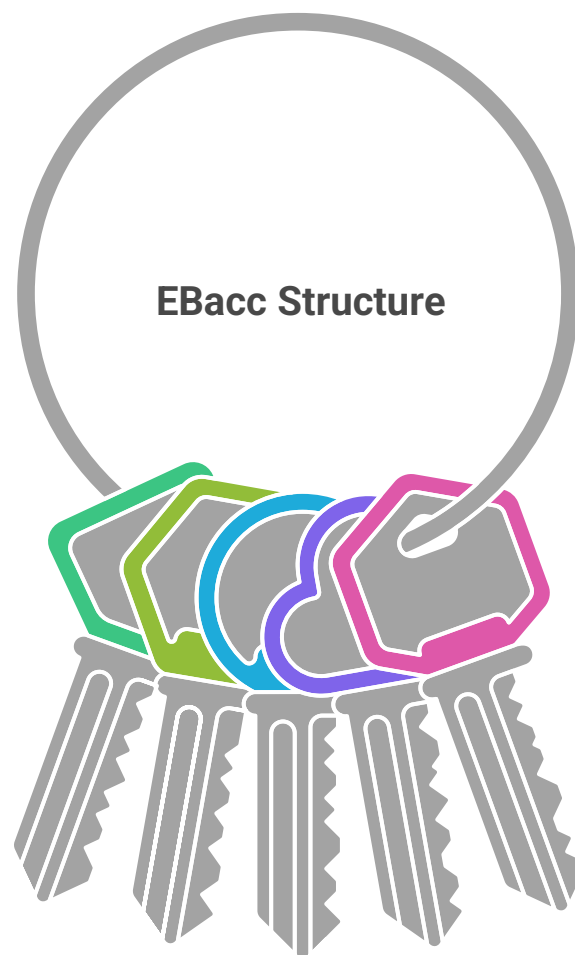
EBacc

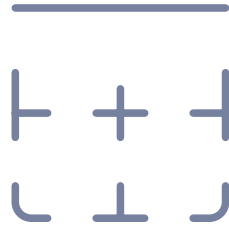

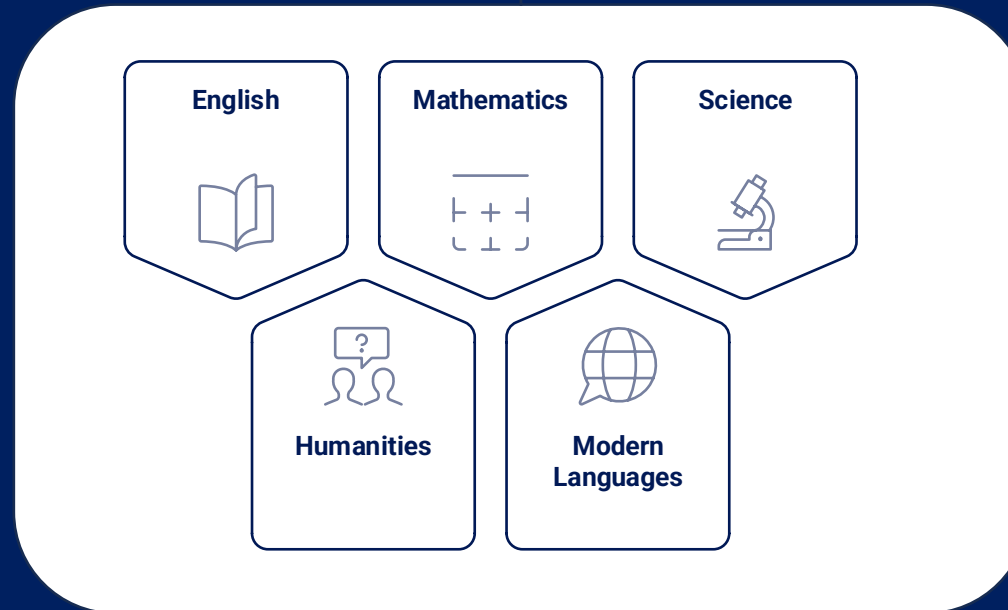
Research suggests that students who take EBacc subjects show a strong academic foundation and tend to have:
