Lund Sustainability Summit

It is with great joy that we are writing to inform you of the finalised logistics for the trip to Sweden from Sunday 27th – Wednesday 30th March!

Flights and Travel:

We will meet at Passmores Academy on **Sunday morning at 5.30am** to arrive at Stansted for 6.00am.

Flights are booked from Stansted Airport on Sunday 27th March, departing at 8.40am local time, and will arrive in Copenhagen Airport, Denmark 11.20am local time (FR 7384).

On return we will depart from Copenhagen Airport at 22.10pm, with a scheduled arrival in Stansted at 23:00pm (FR 7385). We will return on the minibus to Passmores, at approximately midnight.

Regarding restrictions for travel, the procedures for the trip remain that *'Children (under 18 years) accompanying fully vaccinated adults are exempted from the requirement to prove vaccination.'* A more detailed summary of information for travelling to Sweden can be found here:

If anyone does become unwell during the trip, we have arrangements for support staff in Sweden to allow the remainder of the students to continue with the trip and furthermore, additional staff who can support travel at either end. In the event a student or staff member needs to isolate in Sweden, this will be funded by the travel insurance and a female or male member of staff will remain with the student as appropriate.

Accommodation:

It was previously stated we would be able to stay in the School Gymnasium thanks to the generosity of the host school. However, we are fortunate to have received a generous donation to go towards the trip for the young people and, as such, we have now arranged a hotel accommodation for the duration of the trip so as previously stated **no sleeping bag** will be required. Packing:

Students will need Passport, EHC card and a small amount of money. The organisers have informed us all meals will be provided so there should be no food costs. There will be an opportunity for students to visit Lund, where they may wish to purchase some souvenirs. Students have priority boarding which allows for two cabin bags: 1) a small personal bag (max size: 40x20x25cm), and 2) a 10kg or lighter wheellie bag (max size: 55x40x20cm). Students need to pack sensible clothing for the three days of activities and should pack a pencil case and notepad.

Itinerary:

As mentioned, whilst in Lund, your son/daughter will participate in many workshops, visit science centres, and listen to experts in the field of sustainability. Many of the conference activities are taking place at the Vattenhallen Science Centre in Lund and the event is being hosted by our colleagues at Kunskapsskolan, Trelleborg.
