Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Possible school trip to Barcelona around 3rd – 5th March 2023

We are in the very early stages of organising a three-day school trip to Barcelona to begin on Friday 3rd March 2023. This trip will initially be open to students in Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11, who are taking Spanish and/or art and/or photography only. This trip is directly relevant to their curricula and will give students the opportunity to use the skills learnt in the real world. Students will also learn across a range of other curriculum areas at the same time and the experience of such an incredible journey will hopefully stay with them for a lifetime.

In order to finalise the costs, I will need a provisional number of how many students will be interested in going on the trip. As you might expect from any trip abroad, this is an expensive experience; however, students would have the chance to experience real Spanish culture.

The activities included in the price would be:

Visit to Nou Camp - Students will not only see the stadium but will be exposed to professionals who use multiple languages every day in their job.

Visit La Boquería food market – A chance to order food, haggle, buy items. There are opportunities to speak Spanish, take photos and sketches for coursework portfolios.

Visit La Port Vell – To enjoy some shopping and speaking Spanish. Students can take sketches and photos of the port area.

Visit Parc Güell – A chance to also visit the Gaudí museum within the park, as well as visit shops and see beautiful views of the city.

Visit the Picasso Museum – A chance to look at Picasso's artistic career.

Visit to Las Ramblas (Spain's shopping district and centre of cafe society) - a chance to engage socially with Spanish people and order in restaurants/bars.

Visit to La Sagrada Familia Cathedral - Cathedral designed by Antoni Gaudí, one of Spain's most influential architects. Learn the story of Gaudi's life and of the cathedral's near-destruction during the Spanish civil war.

There are potentially other activity costs that may be incurred: around the £15-£20 mark.

We aim to book this trip with a reputable company on an all-inclusive basis, where full board will be provided. Sleeping arrangements will be youth hostel-style/ shared accommodation in dormitories, to keep costs as low as possible. The estimated cost for this trip, including all transfers, will be around the £500 mark; however, this price is dependent on the number of students interested, and it may rise or drop depending on numbers.
