- Access to academic progress and attainment reports
- > Notifications when achievement and behaviour entries have been added to a record
- Access to update contact details, so we always have the most up-to-date information in case of an emergency
- > When it is time to choose options in Year 9 these can be chosen in the SIMS Options section
